In the past year, it's been incredible to witness eleven young people get baptised! Newday - a Christian youth festival with around 9,500 attendees - played a key role in their faith journeys.

This Summer Gift Day, we have another opportunity to invest in the next generation. In July 2025, we're heading to Newday with a group from King's and from another church in Haywards Heath. We also have the privilege of 23 young people joining us from New Ground churches across the South of France.

We're committed to keeping costs as low as possible so that no one misses out. Families will cover ticket fees and we're aiming to raise £15,000 to cover Newday expenses and other youth opportunities through our Summer Gift Day.
