Now we are looking ahead to our **Autumn Gift Days**, and once again we are stepping out in faith together.

A BIG FAITH GOAL

This autumn we are praying for £80,000. It's a big faith goal, but one we believe God has put before us as Elders and Trustees of The King's Church. Of this:

- 75% will strengthen our general funds helping us keep King's open, warm, and welcoming, fund ministries, resource staff and ensure we do all that we can to love God, love people, and see lives and communities transformed.
- 15% will support our Love Your Neighbour ministries meeting urgent needs here in Mid-Sussex.
- **10%** will go to *New Ground* supporting church planting and gospel initiatives across the UK and further afield.

GENERAL FUNDS

We are so privileged to have a church building that has become a hub for the local community. Most people's first contact with us is not on a Sunday, but through the many weekday events and groups hosted here. Our thriving coffee house serves over 33,000 customers annually and plays a key role in the life of **The King's Centre, which remains one of our greatest opportunities for connecting with the community and sharing God's love**. Alongside this, our building enables us to run our weekly church service, host life groups and courses, run our youth group and so much more!

As the cost of running the centre has continued to rise over the last few years due to the challenging economic climate, **75% of the gift day** will be allocated to sustaining this vital resource.

Recently, on our Hope Into Action Sunday, we heard James share his story. It was moving and inspiring to hear how his life has been transformed through this ministry. **Stories like James' remind us that lives really are being changed through our Love Your Neighbour initiatives**. We are so grateful for the dedicated teams who serve our local community. Week after week, their time, care, and skill make a real difference. Here's just two examples:

- Through *Hope Into Action*, new tenants move into safe homes with cupboards full, dignity restored, and hope for the future.
- Through King's Auto Repairs, people who can't afford vital car repairs are kept on the road - enabling people to attend medical appointments, keep jobs and get children to school.

These are life-changing ministries, and we are praying that we may be able to give **15%** from our Gift Days to continue and strengthen this work.

FURTHER AFIELD

King's is also part of the New Ground family of churches, with opportunities to serve and support churches in the UK and overseas. As part of the New Ground core team, during 2025 I have had the privilege of serving churches in Liverpool, Lisbon, Sidcup, Seaford, Oxted, and Eastbourne, and have plans developing for a visit in 2026 to serve our New Ground churches in Brazil. I am humbled that we get to do this and grateful for the way the team at King's release me for this to happen.

New Ground has many opportunities to strengthen and grow what we are doing, and we are praying that we may be able to give 10% towards this wider mission.
